Total score percentage: Use the formula of total score/total possible.	% = total/90
For example, if a paper is 8 for each category, the total score percentage	
will be: $8*9/90 = 80\%$ .	

\* These three apply to Proceedings only, so the total possible for the proposal is 60 while Proceedings is 90. When a proposal is submitted, the study is not necessarily done. That is why we do not include the three \* criteria for proposals. By saying so, we do not mean that you do not need to include data analysis and discussion in your proposal. If the study is done, please provide details; if the study is going to be conducted, provide your plan on data analysis and the discussion. Reviewers will provide their feedback to positively advise you on how to revise for a better Proceedings paper submission when it is relevant.
